WHAT IS CAPS?



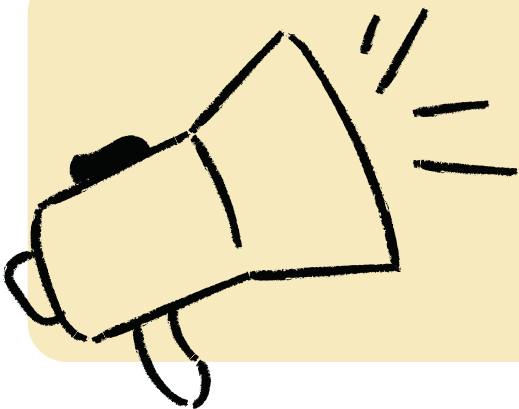
Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS) helps low-income families pay for child care through child care scholarships while that parent(s) works, attends school or training, or participates in work-related activities.

CAPS ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for CAPS, families must belong to one of Georgia's identified priority groups, meet income requirements, and participate in a state-approved activity.



NEW STUDENT PARENT PRIORITY GROUP



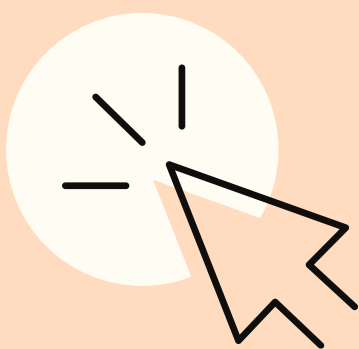
Effective, May 1, 2022, CAPS created the ***Student Parent Priority Group***.
